Mrs. Esther Aina Osaniyi was born about 80 years ago into the Eledingbin family of Afao Quarter, Ikere-Ekiti. Her mother's name was Alice Ogunmoowe from Odo family of Afao Quarter, Ikere-Ekiti. She attended St. John's African Church Primary School where she obtained her first Leaving Certificate. It was not easy for her to continue her education there after because of the poor background, but as faith would have it, she was awarded a scholarship by the Ekiti South District Council through the help of Chief S.O. Agbomoagan who was the headmaster of the newly established African Church Modern School at Afao Quarters; Ikere-Ekiti. She passed her examination in flying colours in the early sixties. Thereafter she relocated to Ibadan where she was employed as a teacher and during this time she proceeded for the Teaching Training College to train as a professional teacher, she passed out in flying colours. She combined our teaching career with the establishment of a flourishing coaching centre at Mokola, Ibadan. She was married to Late Mr. Osaniyi from Ikare Akoko in 1964 and the marriage is blessed with promising and successful children who were raised in the fear of the Lord. As a result of the creation of Ondo State in February 1976, She had to relocate with her husband who was a Civil Servant in the Ministry to Akure. During this period, she obtained the Associateship Certificate in Education from the University of Ife, Ile-Ife Nigeria. Her husband died in 1981, and she became a widow at a relatively young age and she faced the task of raising her children alone and with the help of God she was able to give all of them a befitting education.

She founded a flourishing and successful Nursery and Primary School at FaloduStreet, Osinle Quarter Akure after her retirement. She relocated to the United States and went to the New York University where she obtained a bachelors of art in human psychology. We pray that God will grant her body a peaceful repos.
