Gwendolyn Phillis Elizabeth Chandler was born July 28, 1941 in Nashville, TN to the parents of Bertha L. Mason and James Mason. Her parents and sister Bertha Hunter preceded her in death.

Gwendolyn Chandler, B.S., M.S., MT (ASCP) was a Microbiology professor for the Nursing Program at El Centro College for over 20 years. She was a medical technologist, laboratory director, and office manager at Chandler Medical Plaza, where she practiced with her husband and son, Donald S. Chandler, MD (FAAP) and Donald S. Chandler, Jr., Ph.D. Mrs. Chandler was a woman of many talents as a painter and writer. Her works include *Heros of Faith*, *Some Bible Friends*, and *the People Called Baptist* which were published by the Sunday School Publishing Board. Other works include *Nurture Remembered*, *Voices From Within*, *The Shadow that Watches*, and *Like Rain Falling*. She was a Peace Corp Volunteer and Civil Rights advocate during the late 1960's, earning her community service recognition as an *Unsung Hero* by local charities and U.S. Congressional members.
