### Reflections of Life and Legacy

Maxine Virginia Myles Blackwell was born to the union of the late Milling and Willie Mae Myles on September 24, 1925, in Lawton, Oklahoma. After the passing of her mother in 1934, she moved and lived in Texarkana, Arkansas, with her Aunt, Queen Esther. Maxine Virginia Myles Blackwell was the oldest sibling. Her brother, Milling Myles, preceded her in death.

She received her education and graduated in Texarkana, Arkansas.

Maxine Virginia Myles Blackwell later moved to Dallas, Texas, in the early 50's and married Marvin Blackwell, who preceded her in death.

Maxine Virginia Myles Blackwell was a devoted, loyal, and dedicated member at Full Gospel Holy Temple for over 40 years under the leadership of Apostle Lobias Murray.
