Daddy my love for you will continue to grow each and everyday. I didn't prepare myself for this, your loss came so unexpectedly. I thought for sure many more years we would have to share.

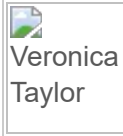
But God had other plans for you Daddy, at this time the loss and grief is something I just can't bear.
